



## Start a ThinkFirst Chapter

It only takes three steps:

1. **Determine Your Chapter Directors:** 1) ThinkFirst Chapter Director—usually an injury prevention coordinator/educator in your trauma or community education department, and 2) ThinkFirst Medical Director—a physician who shares the passion for injury prevention education, to serve as medical advisor/advocate. Each may have a co-director if desired.
2. **Apply:** Submit the ThinkFirst Chapter Application, Directors' resumes/CVs, and the one-time \$1,500.00 Chapter application fee to the ThinkFirst Foundation. Fee includes Chapter training, program materials, ThinkFirst membership benefits and one conference registration worth \$350 (see below).
3. **Train:** Schedule training with the ThinkFirst Foundation. Chapter training is a one-day course that includes chapter development, program implementation, evaluation and more. Training is offered monthly online, onsite or at the annual ThinkFirst Conference on Injury Prevention.

Once training has been completed, Chapter Directors are provided with website login codes to access chapter resources: presentation videos, PowerPoints, scripts, handouts, evaluation tools and more. Monthly e-newsletters keep directors informed and our knowledgeable staff provides continued support.
